
HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 285

- 1. Update on operations and service requirements relating to COVID-19 epidemic.

 - d. appoint Paying Agent/Registrar and Escrow Agent;
 - e. adopt Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of the District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2021 and authorize the Board of Directors to sign all documents relating to the sale of the bonds;
 - f. authorize the District's attorney and the financial advisor to take all necessary action in connection with the issuance of the District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2021;
 - g. execution of Certificate Regarding Provision of Financial Advice;
 - h. approve payment to Attorney General relating to bond issue transcript review.

- 11. Security services matters, including report from Harris County Sheriff's Office.
- 12. Development in the District.
- 13. North Channel Water Authority report.



- 14. Detention facilities report, including proposals and task orders for additional maintenance.

- 16. Engineer's report on construction projects in the District, including the following:
 - a. authorize design of facilities in the service area, including:
 - i. expansion to Liberty Lakes lift station (lift station no. 2);
 - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids for construction of facilities in the service area, including:
 - i. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Beltway 8/US 90 Commercial Subdivision Tract 5; and
 - ii. lift station to serve Beltway 8/US 90 Commercial Subdivision Tract 5;
 - c. review bids and award contracts for construction of facilities in the service area, including:
 - i. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve New Forest Parkway, Section 2; and
 - ii. water plant expansion, including storm water pump station and force main:
 - d. approve pay estimates, time extensions, change orders, certificates of completion and final acceptance for projects in the service area, including:
 - water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Beltway 8/US 90 Commercial Subdivision Tracts 4 and 6; and
 - ii. detention pond and storm water pump station to serve Beltway 8/US 90 Commercial Subdivision Tract 5;
 - e. deeds, easements, plats, surveys, as-built certifications, appraisals, and consents to encroachment;
 - f. utility commitment requests; and
 - g. proposals for engineering services.
- 17. Operator's report, including:
 - a. update on operation, maintenance, and repair of District water, sanitary sewer, and storm water facilities;
 - b. update on customer billing and collection; and
 - c. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
- 18. Approve annual report on implementation of Water Conservation Plan, and authorize submittal to the Texas Water Development Board, if required.
