WHEREAS, the term of office of four (4) trustees in Single-Member District Positions one (1), (two (2), four (4) and five (5) expire on the 1st day of May 2021, and on said date, a Trustee election will be held in said School District; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT that an election be held in said School District on May 1, 2021, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing to the Board of Trustees of said School District four (4) School Trustees for full terms to fill Single-Member District Positions one (1), two (2), four (4) and five (5).

EARLY VOTING by personal appearance will begin on Monday, April 19, 2021, and end on Tuesday, April 27, 2021. APPLICATIONS FOR MAIL BALLOTS

Voters may apply for a ballot by mail at any time, however the last day to apply for ballot by mail is at the close of business on Tuesday, April 20, 2021. Note: the application must be received and postmarked by this date, Residents applying for a ballot by mail shall send their application to the Early Voting Clerk of the county in which they are registered to vote. *Please note: The law has changed. To be effective, an application for ballot by mail submitted by FAX or EMAIL, must be submitted by mail and be received by the early voting clerk not later than the fourth business day after the transmission by fax or email. (TEC84.007)

All voting in the election, including early voting by personal appearance, shall be done through the use of electronic voting system as adopted by the Harris County Commissioners Court.

ELECTION SUPPLIES AND BALLOTS shall be printed in English, Spanish, Vietnamese, and Traditional Chinese. Such election supplies shall include, but not be limited to all forms, signs, and other materials used by the election judges at all polling places.

APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION OFFICERS, the election judges, alternate judges, clerks and other personnel necessary for conducting the election will be appointed by the Harris County Election Administrator.

A CENTRAL COUNTING STATION shall be at the location designated by Harris County.

THE SECRETARY TO THE BOARD shall cause a notice of said election to be published in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese in a newspaper of general circulation in the Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District not more than thirty (30) days and not less than ten (10) days prior to the election and posting notice on the bulletin board used for posting notices of Board of Trustees meetings not later than the 21st day before the election. Additionally, a substantial copy of the Election Order shall be posted in three public places in the District not later than the 21st day before the Election and shall be posted on the District's website during the 21days before the Election, and shall be posted on Election Day and during early voting by personal appearance in a prominent location at each polling place. Notice of the Election shall also be provided to the Harris County Election Administrator no later than the 60th day before the Election Day.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL CANVASS THE RETURNS of the election not earlier than the third (3rd) day or later than the eleventh (11th) day after the Election Day. The canvass may not be conducted until Harris County Ballot Board has verified and counted all ballots cast at election locations, all provisional ballots, if a provisional ballot has been cast in the election, and all timely received ballots cast from addresses outside the United States.

THE VOTING PRECINCTS AND LOCATIONS TO BE USED BY THE DISRICT IN CONDUCTING THE ELECTION IN HARRIS COUNTY are set forth in Exhibit A. The Harris County Elections Administrator is authorized to appoint any such other officials and locations herein or appointed by the Harris County Elections Administrator, as are necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in accordance with the Code.

Said election shall be held in accordance with the Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, including particularly Chapter 272 of the code pertaining to bilingual requirement. Such election shall be held by election officials appointed by Harris County Commissioners Court, or its designee, for voters in Harris County.
