**VERIFIED PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON PLAINTIFF'S  
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR PERMANENT SEALING ORDER**

Under Texas Rule of Civil Procedure 76a(3), Plaintiff Amazing Lash Franchise, LLC ("Plaintiff" or "ALF"), posts this Public Notice of the hearing in open court on Plaintiff's Unopposed Second Motion for Permanent Sealing Order in the above case. The hearing will be held on December 11, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. and will take place before the 133rd Judicial District, located at the Harris County Civil Courthouse, 201 Caroline Street, 9th floor, Houston, Texas 77002. At the Court's discretion, all appearance shall be in person. At the hearing, any person may intervene and be heard concerning the sealing of court records.

The records sought to be sealed are Exhibits 4, 7, 11, and 15-19 to ALF's Emergency Motion for Contempt, Sanctions, and a Temporary Restraining Order and Temporary Injunction Due to Defendants' Violations of a Court Order, filed on September 14, 2023 (the "Court Records"). The Court Records include ALF's business operations manual, which details how to conduct an ALF franchise, defines the client list, and—in sum—contains the operational trade secrets of the business, which is of paramount value to the company. The Court Records also include customer lists containing confidential trade secrets—the very information the Defendants used to promote their competing business in violation of this Court's April 5, 2023 TRO. Finally,

the Court Records contain both sensitive, personal information of declarants, as well as confidential trade secrets, including customer information.

The Court Records are essential to Plaintiff's causes of action for breach of contract and violation of the Texas Uniform Trade Secrets Act. By its claims, Plaintiff alleges that Defendants improperly ceased operation of their studios in violation of the franchise agreements and misappropriated ALF's trade secrets to compete against ALF. ALF must utilize the Court Records to fully brief and argue its case, but the confidential nature of the Court Records restricts public disclosure.

The parties are not asking the Court to seal any court order or petition.

Plaintiff has served unredacted copies of the Court Records on the Defendants. Plaintiff now requests that the Court permanently seal the Court Records.

A verified copy of this Public Notice will also be filed with the clerk of the court in which the case is pending and with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Texas.
