- 13. Hear from the public.\*

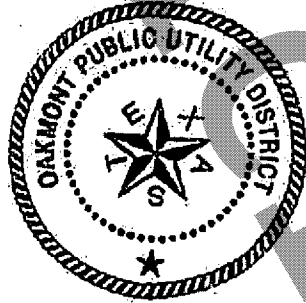

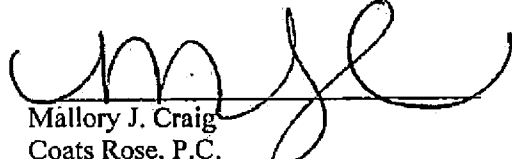

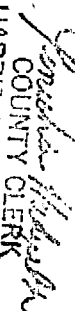
