### **Election Day for the December 14 Joint Runoff Election is Saturday**

**(HOUSTON, TX)**—Early voting for the December 14 Joint Runoff Election has ended, with 1,870 voters casting their ballots during the early voting period. Eligible voters who have not yet participated will have their final opportunity to vote on Election Day, Saturday, December 14, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

#### **Election Day Information**

On Election Day, [42 vote centers](#) will be open across the districts participating in the runoff election. Voters can visit any of these locations to cast their ballot, providing flexibility and convenience.

#### **Runoff Election Contests**

This election includes two important local contests:

- City of Baytown, Mayor
- Lone Star College System, Trustee, District 1

Only voters registered within the boundaries of these respective districts are eligible to vote. To confirm eligibility, view a sample ballot, or find polling locations, visit [HarrisVotes.com](https://www.harrisvotes.com).

Voters should bring one of the [seven acceptable forms of photo ID](#) to the polls. A Reasonable Impediment Declaration with supporting documentation is accepted for voters who cannot reasonably obtain one.

“Election Day is your final opportunity to have your say in these critical local contests,” **said Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth**. “Your voice matters, and I encourage every eligible voter to make a plan to cast their ballot on Saturday.”
