HARRIS COUNTY CLERK REINSTATES WALK-IN SERVICES

(Houston, TX) – Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth announces that walk-in services have been reinstated at all [11 locations](#) now that the COVID-19 threat level has been lowered to Level 3-Yellow. According to the county’s guidance, Level 3 signifies a moderate, but controlled level of COVID-19 in Harris County.

“Last January, our office reinstated by appointment services when the threat level was elevated to Level 1-Red and restricted walk-ins,” said **Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth**. “Currently, all previously set appointments will be honored, but if clients want to come in at an earlier date, they can, they just need to let the attending clerk know about the change.”
