Local Voices, Strong Choices

Joint Runoff Election is June 7

(Houston, TX) – Voters in the city of Pasadena and the San Jacinto College District will have their final opportunity to cast ballots in the Joint Runoff Election on Saturday, June 7. The runoff follows the May Election, where several local races remain undecided because no candidate received more than 50% of the vote. The following races will be decided in the runoff:

- City of Pasadena – Mayor
- City of Pasadena – Districts A, B, and G
- San Jacinto Community College District – Position 3

"Democracy thrives when we participate," **said Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth.** "This is the last chance for voters to step up and be heard."

[Seventy-six vote centers](#) will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

To vote in person, registered voters must present one of the following acceptable forms of photo identification:

- Texas Driver's License
- Texas Election Identification Certificate
- Texas Personal ID Card
- Texas Handgun License
- United States Military Photo ID
- United States Citizenship Certificate (with photo)
- United States Passport (book or card)

Voters who do not have one of these forms of ID may complete a [Reasonable Impediment Declaration](#) (RID) at a Vote Center and present another form of identification, such as a utility bill, bank statement, government check, or voter registration certificate.

Clerk Hudspeth emphasized the importance of civic engagement: "Even if you did not vote in the May 3 Election, the runoff is still a chance to weigh in on important matters in your community."
