Harris County Clerk's Office Unveils New Marriage License Design

Houston, TX– The Harris County Clerk's Office has released a new marriage license and keepsake certificate. Issuing marriage licenses is one of the many services offered by the Harris County Clerk's Office. You can apply for a marriage license at the County Clerk's main branch located in the Harris County Civil Courthouse at 201 Caroline, Suite 460 or any of the 9 annex locations located around the county.

"It is important that marriage licenses are reflective of the diverse nature of Harris County and is inclusive of all relationships", **said Harris County Clerk Diane Trautman.**

Data Sales Supervisor Charles Clark is responsible for the redesign. "This has been one of the most impactful projects I've worked on in my 18 years with the county", **said Clark** "I wanted to give the license the elegance and authenticity it deserves".

To obtain a marriage license, both parties will need to appear in person and provide identification (State Issued I.D., Driver's License, Passport, etc.) No appointment is necessary, the State mandated processing fee is \$72 and the new keepsake marriage certificate is available for \$25.
