Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth Sworn-in for Full Term Welcomes Former County Treasurer Dylan Osborne as New Finance Administrator

(Houston, TX) – Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth was sworn-in for her first full term as County Clerk on January 2, 2023. Hudspeth was re-elected Harris County Clerk during the November 8 mid-term elections. Judge Jason Cox, Harris County Probate Court #3, administered the Clerk's oath of office, prior to the general investiture ceremony that took place at the NRG Center.

"I am humbled and honored to serve as County Clerk of the largest county in the State of Texas and third largest in the U.S.," **said Clerk Hudspeth.** "I will continue working to bring this office into the 21st century by improving customer service, strengthening the office's technology, and providing additional services to underserved communities through partnerships and nonprofits."

Clerk Hudspeth also announced that former Harris County Treasurer Dylan Osborne is joining her office as the new Administrator of Finance. Osborne served as County Treasurer for a full four-year term (2019-2022) and is now ready to start a new endeavor at the Harris County Clerk's Office (HCCO).

"Mr. Osborne has a strong background in public administration, finance, and budgeting," **said Clerk Hudspeth**. "He is extremely qualified and is a great addition to my executive staff."

Prior to serving as Harris County Treasurer, Osborne worked as a constituent service representative and policy advisor for the City of Houston and as a community liaison. He also served in the City of Houston's Finance and the Planning & Development Departments.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to continue serving the residents of Harris County," **said Osborne.** "I look forward to working with this great team of professionals and continue to strengthen the services the Clerk's office provides the public."

Osborne fills the function formerly carried out by Danny Sumrall who will soon retire after serving Harris County, with great devotion, for close to 39 years.
